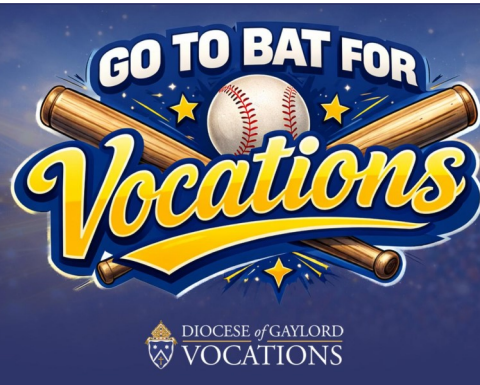

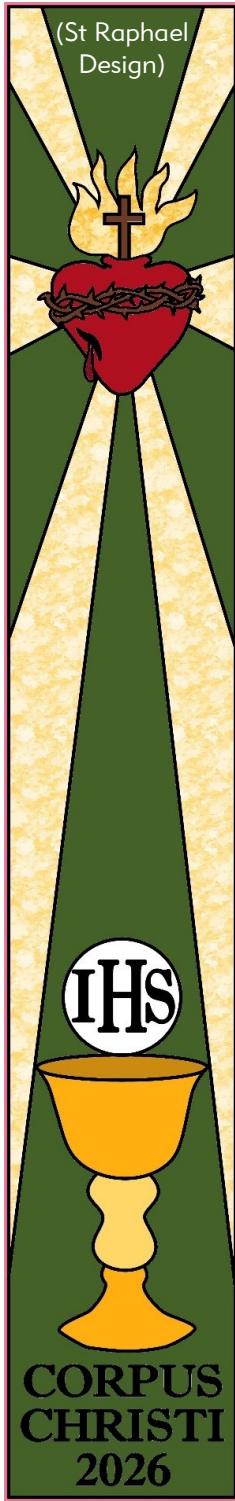
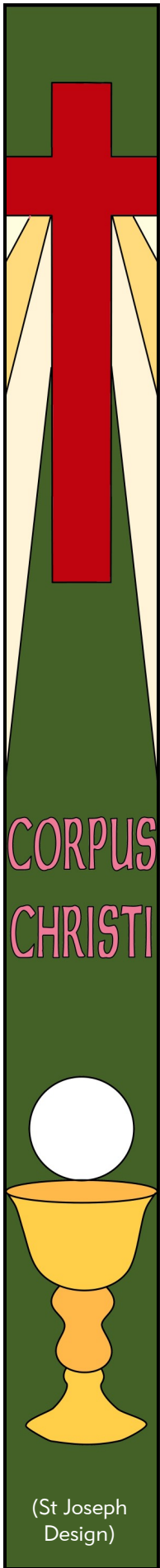

**Announcing our 1st Infiorata
planned for the
Feast of Corpus Christi
on Sunday, June 7th**

An Infiorata is a floral carpet decorated with natural materials, e.g. cedar boughs and flower petals. This is an annual Italian festival that started in Noto, Italy. The floral carpet will be placed in the main aisle of the church, and reserved for Father to carry the Blessed Sacrament over on Corpus Christi. We will begin decorating the carpet runner on Friday, June 5, in the church at St. Joseph of Onekama, and will need many volunteers (young and older) to help with the preparation of materials (cutting and separating petals and rose leaves from stems, refilling trays of same, etc.) and decorating it. **Please let the office know** if we can count on you to help with this humble sacrifice of time and talent.

Joe & Bobbie Brooks will be organizing the Infiorata for St. Raphael of Copemish. Both churches will need many cedar boughs. **If you can bring in green cedar boughs to the churches on the last weekend of May, or 1st of June, we would truly appreciate it.**
